

# FALL SEMESTER CALENDAR AND COURSE CATALOGUE 2020

## OPTION 1: Normal Fall Semester

- Arrival date to Sevilla: September 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Classes begin on October 5<sup>th</sup> at SAIE and at Universidad de Sevilla.
- Departure date from Sevilla: December 18<sup>th</sup>.

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:** Students must choose at least one class in Spanish at SAIE and the Artistic Monuments in Sevilla (in English OR in Spanish). The student must take at least 12 credits (four classes) during the semester.

**PROGRAM FEES: \$9,600 USD.** This includes the new Orientation week, welcome and farewell dinners, housing with most meals, a weekend trip to Morocco, day excursions to Córdoba, Ronda and Itálica.

## **OPTION 2: Virtual Fall Semester**

- Virtual Orientation and Presentation: September 28th
- Classes begin on October 5<sup>th</sup>
- Final Exams: December 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:** Students must choose a total of FOUR classes from the SAIIE OR the Universidad de Sevilla Course Lists (equivalent to 12 credits).

**PROGRAM FEES: \$5,100.** This includes an optional week in Sevilla from January 17<sup>th</sup> to January 23<sup>rd</sup> (2021), where the SAIIE Staff would arrange and organise different visits and activities that will help get a taste of Sevilla and its culture. These visits include the Cathedral, the Giralda and the Alcazar of Sevilla. This fee also includes housing and all meals.

- Classes begin on December 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Final exam on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, departing from Sevilla on January 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:** As this is an SAIE exclusive program designed to fully complete and experience a Study Abroad Experience with us, the only requirement is to participate on our Virtual Fall Semester to benefit from this special offer.

**PROGRAM FEES:**

**-\$5,100 USD for the Virtual Fall Semester**

**-\$2,500 USD for Winterim**

This includes housing, most of the meals, trips to Córdoba and Granada (1 night) plus all the cultural visits throughout the program.
